

Habitat for Humanity Greater Orlando & Osceola County has made the difficult decision to close our two ReStore locations and discontinue our retail line of business to focus solely on our mission to provide affordable housing, effective January 31, 2019.

The decision to close the ReStores was not entered into lightly and came only after we reviewed every option to maximize the impact of our mission and best serve our community. We are grateful for the support our frequent shoppers and donors have shown us for the past 16 years.

Affected staff members have been notified and all have been offered severance and employment resources to assist them in their job transitions.

Habitat for Humanity is an organization with a proud history and legacy of providing simple, decent affordable housing throughout the world. The Board and Staff believe Central Florida will be well served by the organization's continued focus and fulfillment of that core mission in Greater Orlando and Osceola County.

Since our establishment in 1986, we have built over 353 homes and rehabilitated over 355 homes, impacting thousands of Central Floridians. Habitat for Humanity Greater Orlando & Osceola County remains steadfastly committed to building homes, revitalizing communities, and strengthening our community.
